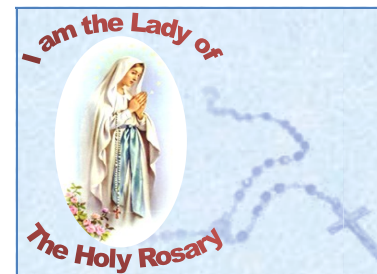
Uganda Project

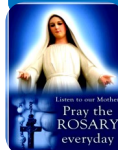
