2nd Sunday in Ordinary Time greetings,

On January 22nd we acknowledge the anniversary of Roe VS. Wade: the decision of the courts that made abortion the rule of the land. We are asked to make a day of penance and reparation for the loss of so many innocent lives. We can pray but we can also fast or abstain from meat. It is a good day to acknowledge the importance of children. We should not be silent but aware that it is silence that allows this to continue. Abortion is wrong. It is murder. In Fargo at the abortion mill the equivalent of 1 classroom (approx 20 + babies) of children is silenced each week, 52 classrooms a year.

I feel compassion also for the fathers and mothers of the babies that are aborted. I know the parents hurt and later in life do not know where to turn. I would welcome the opportunity to talk with you and help you restore your relationship with God and bring peace to your life. There are ways to right the wrong.

**Adoration update:** Every Tuesday we close Mass with Benediction and start a time for us as a community to adore Jesus in the monstrance and also receive His blessing. As a parish we invite you to consider participating in Adoration (personal time in front of the Blessed Sacrament.) When we spend time in front of the exposed Blessed Sacrament, we are literally having a face-to-face conversation with God. Personal time with Jesus is a gift. He listens to our voice, and we listen to the voice of God. He may speak to us through our meditation, a scripture passage, a song, or a prayer we say.

We have open hours in our schedule. Would you be willing to attend? Several adorers headed south for the winter and a couple adorers have passed away and are seeing in a clearer way the visible face of Jesus. We have a need to visit with Jesus. It is as simple as: stop in and spend 5 minutes, 10 minutes, 15 minutes, or whatever time is available for you. On all other days: Jesus may not be exposed in the monstrance, but He is present in the tabernacle and in our parish. Call the office if you want a regular time for adoration.

I remembered and found a teaching by the Pope on family life we can use in both our personal families and also when we as the family of the church are gathered together. He said: "Remember the three key phrases: Excuse me; thank you; I'm sorry!" Then he went on during his Wednesday audience to say to the people: "In a family that uses these words, there is peace and joy! And He asked everyone to practice on someone else nearby, He led it off with: "say it with me, excuse me; thank you; I'm sorry!" Let's follow his lead... practice practice...

One more quote from Pope Francis, a top 10 list of things to do.

1. Don't gossip.
2. Finish your meals.
3. Make time for others.
4. Choose the 'more humble' purchase.
5. Meet the poor 'in the flesh.'
6. Stop judging others.
7. Befriend those who disagree.
8. Make commitments, such as marriage!
9. Make it a habit to 'ask the Lord.'
10. Be happy.

I make it a practice to lend material from my personal library to those who could use a good author or thoughts regarding a difficulty or experience they are having... However, I went to my shelves last week to get a book to share and both copies were gone... If I have lent you a good book and you have finished reading it, would you please return it so I can send it home with someone else.

Jesus loves you and so do I... Blessings on your day! Fr Chuck

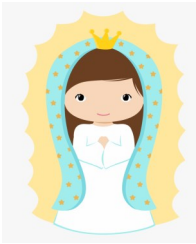


Holy Rosary will be hosting two special celebrations for boys and girls ages 4 through 4th grade to learn and celebrate their dignity as a beloved child of God:
