The Gloria: "Glory to God in the highest, and peace on earth to people of good will" (Luke 2:15). The Gloria is sung on Sundays outside of Advent and Lent, solemnities, and feasts. Often referred to as "the Angelic Hymn", the Gloria was first intoned by angels from heaven for the birth of Christ on earth. The Gloria is a true hymn. Its opening burst of praise overflows into a series of joyful cries addressed to the Father: "We praise you, we bless you, we worship you, we give you thanks for your great glory".

The hymn goes on to implore the mercy of the Son, the Lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world. In singing the Gloria the Church relives the experience of St. Stephen who, "full of the Holy Spirit, gazed into heaven and saw the glory of God, and Jesus standing at the right hand of God" (Acts 7:55). Gazing on Christ, the Church praises him: "You alone are the Holy One, you alone are the Lord, you alone are the Most High". The final lines of the Gloria soar into the blinding mystery of the Trinity: "Jesus Christ, with the Holy Spirit, in the glory of God the Father". The hymn ends where it began: in the heavens.






Greetings to you, this Twenty-Second Sunday of Ordinary Time.






