
Pre-Marriage retreat April 6th-7th 2024

The Outpouring of the Holy Spirit


"The Counselor, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, he will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all that I have said to you" (John 14:25). Ceaselessly the Holy Spirit brings to our remembrance the life-giving words of Jesus: "This is my body which is given for you" (Luke 22:19). In the Eucharistic Prayer, while giving thanks to the Father, the Church "implores the power of the Holy Spirit that the gifts offered by human hands be consecrated, that is, become Christ's Body and Blood" (GIRM, art. 79). The Church also prays that, by the action of the Holy Spirit, "the spotless Victim to be received in Communion be for the salvation of those who will partake of it" (GIRM, art. 79). At the Annunciation (cf. Luke 1:35) the Holy Spirit overshadowed the Virgin Mary, forming the Body of Christ in her womb. At Pentecost (cf. Acts 2:4) the Holy Spirit was present in a mighty wind and tongues of fire to form the Body of Christ, the Church. In every Mass the Holy Spirit makes fruitful the Church's obedience to the command of Christ: "Do this in memory of me" (Luke 22:19).

Merry Christmas!!!! As Catholics, we continue to celebrate the birth of Jesus through Monday, January 8th at the Feast of the Baptism of Our Lord by John the Baptist. Today, December 31st, we celebrate the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph.

The First Reading today from Sirach provides great wisdom for children....

Whoever honors his father atones for sins.

and preserves himself from them.
When he prays, he is heard;
he stores up riches who reveres his mother.
Whoever honors his father is gladdened by children,
and, when he prays, is heard.
Whoever reveres his father will live a long life;

he who obeys his father brings comfort to his mother.

My son, take care of your father when he is old; grieve him not as long as he lives.

Even if his mind fail, be considerate of him;

revile him not all the days of his life;

kindness to a father will not be forgotten.

firmly planted against the debt of your sins.

To encounter your spiritual parents, first invite one or all of them to be your spiritual parent(s). Such as saying out loud.... "Father God, I want you to be my spiritual parent, help me to know you and to seek you throughout my day to guide me, to keep me safe and so I know your love for me."

Repeat similar words to invite the Blessed Virgin Mary and St. Joseph to be active in your life.

Keep in mind that we all are children, just at different stAGES in life. I seek and pray daily that Father God, the Blessed Virgin Mary and St. Joseph are active throughout my day and my Brother Jesus, is active in my life too.`

January 1st is Monday... This is the Solemnity of the Blessed Virgin Mary, the Mother of God. Set aside time on January 1st to spend time with the Blessed Virgin Mary. Begin a daily prayer practice with the Hail Mary or The Memorare, both written below. My prayer for you is to have a greater and deeper relationship with God, Jesus, Mary and St. Joseph.

Hail Mary, full of grace, the Lord is with you; Blessed are you among women, and blessed is the fruit of your womb, Jesus.

Holy Mary Mother of God, pray for us sinners now and at the hour of our death. Amen



Forgiving is one of the hardest things for people to do. We can't give what we don't have. We need to receive God's mercy and forgiveness first before we can give it to others. Go to the sacrament of Reconciliation and receive God's mercy and forgiveness. Then, share the gift of forgiveness with someone – a family member, a friend or a co-worker. Pick up the phone or text someone right now.



Sometimes our earthly father or mother has difficulty being the parent we need. In those situations, if possible, first offer from your heart forgiveness, and then mercy.

Remember, Jesus is our brother. This means God the Father is our Father and St. Joseph, the foster father of Jesus, is our foster father too. Mary, the mother of Jesus, is also our mother.

We have earthly parents, and we have spiritual parents... are the spiritual parents active in your life? If not, consider turning to God the Father, the Blessed Virgin Mary and St. Joseph.


