A Letter from Deacon Gary Hager

The National Eucharistic Congress begins on Wednesday, July 17, 2024.

From the webpage of the Eucharistic Congress...

God hears our prayers for the renewal of our Church. He will answer them through a life-changing transformation of our own hearts. The 10th National Eucharistic Congress is an invitation to experience profound personal revival so we can be sent out to share Christ's love with a world that so desperately needs it.

Participating in the Congress on site in Indianapolis or at a distance, transformation is available to everyone with faith. We heard from Gospel readings these past weeks... the woman afflicted with hemorrhages for 12 years is healed... because of her faith. We hear of the synagogue official, his daughter died, Jesus says to him... "Just have faith." Then Jesus took the hand of the child and says, "Little girl, I say to you, arise." She immediately arose and walked around.

You too, because of your faith, are invited to experience a profound personal revival to be sent out to share Christ's love with the world.

Remember....

You are not an accident. The God who created the universe, who set the moon and stars in place, loves YOU and chose YOU, even before the world was formed. He knows you better than you know yourself, and he loves you simply because you are YOU. There are no conditions on his love: at every moment, you are infinitely loved by him. You are dear to him. You were born to live at this time, you have a purpose!

Know that...

Through the Resurrection, Jesus has opened the door for you, and through his Church, he invites you into a personal relationship with God, but God won't force you to choose him. Christ comes to us in the Eucharist, offering himself to us: Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity. He nourishes us, offering himself as "our daily bread." It is easy for us to overlook this extraordinary gift. Even people who go to Mass each Sunday forget that Jesus is not merely symbolically present but truly and substantially... body, blood, soul, and divinity! It's time for us to entrust ourselves to the One who gave his life for us and invites us to encounter him in the Eucharist.

To watch The Eucharistic Congress on TV, live coverage begins on July 17th at 4 p.m. central time, then daily beginning at 6 a.m. central time on EWTN, a Catholic station, through Sunday, ending with the closing Mass.

We pray for safe travel for everyone attending the Eucharistic Congress. Holy Rosary parishioners are already on the journey to Indianapolis, with more leaving today, Monday, and Tuesday.

God bless our nation during the Congress plus the days, months, and years to follow!
