A Letter from Father Nate Brunn

The Power of Resting in Christ... It is amazing when we spend a little bit of time reflecting on our lives where we have seen Christ strengthening us. Two weeks ago, in the second reading we heard about God's grace strengthening us in our weaknesses, last week Jesus sent the twelve out on mission, and this week Jesus says to come away and rest!

In just a short time, Jesus has invited the disciples to enter a deeper life with Him. They chose to make a radical decision to follow Him wherever He led. The miracles that they were witnessing, the lives they saw changed, the energy they spent, and the lessons they were learning were quite incredible. Jesus recognized in them the need to rest.

This rest was not just merely sitting down at the table, in the living, outside, or on a hill, but rather Jesus was inviting them to rest *with Him*. Jesus was giving them the model of how to retreat. Amid all their ministry it was important that they recharge their spiritual zeal. He saw in them what would happen if they don't recharge their souls; they needed to rest in Christ.

Come away and rest is an invitation that Jesus extends to us as well. Everyone has a lot going on in their lives: ball games, travels, studies, housework, jobs, raising a family, etc. and it can be exhausting. So often we are used to pouring ourselves out that we rarely take the time to recharge our spiritual zeal. It is one thing to go to Mass on the weekend, but what happens during the week? To have enough spiritual energy during the week, it takes time every day to charge up our spiritual energy.

How do you pray (rest in Christ)? How do you receive Charity Himself so that you can give Charity to others? We receive Charity (love of God) through our cooperation with His grace. God pours it out abundantly to us when we spend time with Him on a regular basis. Then when one encounters others, they can pour the grace of Charity (love of God) that they have received back out to them through their words and actions. Come, rest with Christ in Mass and in daily prayer and pour the grace that you receive back out into the world through your words and actions!

Most Rev. Dr. Lourdo Anandam from the Diocese of Sivagangai in India was with us for the Masses this past weekend. Our diocese has some priests from India and we have been incredibly blessed with their ministries. Thank you for your support, prayers, and presence this past weekend! He was incredibly grateful for the opportunity to worship with us, and to be able to share about the ministries in his diocese.
