A Letter from Father Nate Brunn

Greetings to Holy Rosary! My name is Fr. Nate Brunn and I am so delighted to be coming to Detroit Lakes! I grew up just outside of Buffalo, MN, with my parents, and I am the youngest of 4 brothers. After graduating high school, I moved to Moorhead to attend Minnesota State University Moorhead and get a teaching degree. It was while I was in college that I fell in love with my Catholic faith, and I have not looked back since!

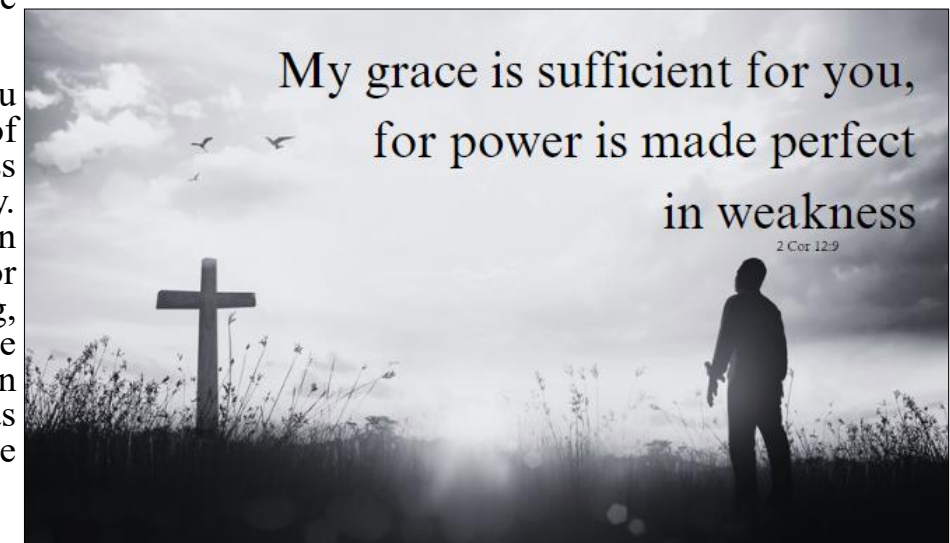
After graduating college, I started teaching in 6th, 7th, and 8th grade at the Catholic school in Moorhead. I taught social studies, language arts, and a few other elective classes. Teaching is something that I loved doing, but I needed a change. The Lord had been inviting me to explore the call to the priesthood. After a few years of trying to figure out where the Lord was leading, I decided in the spring of 2012 to enter seminary. While I was there, I knew that this was the direction the Lord was leading me to! In the spring of 2017, I was ordained a transitional deacon, and in the spring of 2018, I was ordained a priest for the Diocese of Crookston! I have been the associate pastor and director of college ministry at St. Joe's in Moorhead for the past six years. These years have been incredible years of growth and formation in parish, school, and college life.

I love spending time outside as much as possible: fishing, hunting, hiking, or even just relaxing. I am looking forward to our time together as we spread the Good News of Jesus Christ and His love for the whole world!

In the second reading this weekend, we hear St. Paul say to the people of Corinth, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness." This is a beautiful line that St. Paul uses to encourage us amid our perceived weaknesses, to rely on His grace. How easy it can be to rely on our own abilities, and talents and forget about how God gives us what we need when it is needed! Rely on God's strength within you! He will give you courage, fortitude, strength, and hope, especially in the times when you feel you are lacking. It is amazing what God can do in those moments, even when we feel like we can't do it.

Next weekend Most Rev. Dr. Lourdu Anandam from the Diocese of Sivagangai will be joining us for Mass at 5 on Saturday, 9 and 11 on Sunday. Priests from his diocese have been serving the Diocese of Crookston for over 20 years. He will be preaching, and a special second collection will be taken up to support the ministry in India. Thank you for your support as they continue to assist us in our diocese as well!
