
## **Thanksgiving Meal Information**



A Letter from Father Nate Brunn

Jesus, I trust in You! This is the phrase that is at the bottom of the image of the Divine Mercy by St. Faustina. Five seemingly small words that challenge us in our everyday lives. I remember back to when I was really trying to make the decision to enter seminary to study for the priesthood. I had been teaching for a few years and really enjoyed it; I was not sure that I wanted to leave that ministry. Once a month I would meet Fr. Tom (a monk connected to the Order of St. Benedict who lived in SD). During our time together, we would discuss all things spiritual about my life, everything from Mass to prayer to conversations I had with other people to books. This was a way for us to sort through where the Lord might be inviting me to see where He was moving. One piece of advice that he gave me that has stuck with me ever since: find that one small line or phrase that sticks with you and repeat it often, and let the Lord work with it.

At many different moments in my life, I have found myself coming back to the words of the Divine Mercy image: Jesus, I trust in You. When I am faced with uncertainty, confusion, anxiety, or fear—Jesus, I trust in You. In the moments when I am happy, joyful, in a good space—Jesus, I trust in You. In looking back at important moments, making big and small decisions, it is amazing how many times the Lord carried me through when I didn't know what was going to happen. Being able to trust in Jesus is a difficult thing to do because we don't always know where He is going to invite us to go—sometimes not knowing or being in control is the hardest part.

The image in the gospel this weekend shows us incredible trust. The line that St. Mark uses is "her whole livelihood." This is her offering; this is her radical trust that the Lord will provide for her and her needs. I cannot begin to imagine what was going through her mind and her heart when she let go of those coins. Often our desire is to hold on to, or to grasp, but she gives us this image of letting go, of opening her hands. My encouragement to you in those moments when you find yourself holding on to control, power, hurts, pains, unforgiveness, fear, anxiety, and anything else you can identify with: find that small line or phrase that encourages you to open your hands and your heart—like the woman in the gospel this weekend—and trust that the Lord is with you every step of the way!

Sometime in discernment: Since arriving at Holy Rosary in July, I have been spending time getting to know the needs of the parish, school, staff, councils, and the community. In relationship with the finance council, trustees, and others, one of the needs that we have is for a part-time or full-time parish administrator. This is a ministry team member that would minister closely with the parish staff, the school principal, and myself to help guide and support our Holy Rosary Catholic Community as we form disciples for Jesus Christ. If you are interested or know someone who might be, please reach out to Fr. Nate by phone or email. The posting is included in this week's bulletin, is on our website, and will remain until it is filled. I invite you to please pray for this important ministry and the role that they have in our community.

Reminder: I am away this week! I am going to be taking a week to spend time with some great friends. Every year I have been able to get away with some other priests and spend a week together catching up on life, having great food, and having a wonderful time of being together. Thank you to Fr. Pat Sullivan for filling in while I am away!
