We warmly welcome them to Holy Rosary and to the Holy Catholic Church!


Adam Simons received the sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation.

A Message From Deacon Gary

Happy Easter this Second Sunday of Easter, this Sunday is also known as Divine Mercy Sunday.

Holy Rosary observes Divine Mercy on Sunday, April 27th, beginning at 2 pm with Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament. Then at 3 pm, the Divine Mercy Chaplet prayer. A high school Senior to lead the singing of the Chaplet. Everyone attending to receive a handout for praying the Chaplet and a list of the 14 promises attached to praying the Chaplet of Devine Mercy as revealed to St. Faustina Kowalska.

St.John Paul II instituted the Divine Mercy Feast in the year 2000 following the canonization of St. Faustina Kowalska, a Polish nun, that received the Divine Mercy revelations from Jesus beginning in 1931.

The promises from Jesus that St. Faustina recorded in her diary is.... “The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. On that day all the divine floodgates throughout which graces flow are opened. Let no soul fear to draw near to Me. Even though its sins be as scarlet.... Mankind will not have peace until it turns to the Fount of My Mercy.”

The Church gives an explanation as to how to observe Divine Mercy Sunday.

- 1) Sincerely repent of all of your sins.
- 2) Place your complete trust in Jesus.
- 3) Go to Confession, the Church permits up to 20 days before the Feast.
- 4) Receive Holy Communion on Divine Mercy Sunday (or the vigil Mass).
- 5) Venerate the image, such as a prayer before it.

Together, at 3 pm, let us receive the graces available through the Divine Mercy Feast.
