Holy Rosary Parish is hiring two new positions! Come and be a part of our team!

We are seeking a **Coordinator of Youth Evangelization & Discipleship (CYED)** to plan, organize and implement evangelization and discipleship opportunities for youth and assist with the youth Confirmation preparation process. The CYED is part of the parish’s newly formed Catechesis and Evangelization Team. This position is full-time, with a base pay of \$43,000 annually. Their work schedule is flexible and variable and includes some evenings and weekends.

The CYED:

- Develops & implements opportunities for middle and high school youth that help them encounter Jesus Christ and his Church.
- Accompanies youth in the pre-Confirmation and post Confirmation process.
- Recruits, trains and empowers youth and adult volunteers to serve as facilitators, small group leaders, retreat leaders and mentors.
- Desires to share the Kerygma, the Good News of Jesus Christ, with our youth.
- Bachelor’s degree in theology, Catholic studies, pastoral ministry or a related field is helpful.
- Experience in youth ministry or religious education is valuable.
- Excellent organizational, communication and interpersonal skills.

Did You Know?

Notre-Dame du Dimanche (Our Lady of Sunday)


An apparition of the Blessed Virgin Mary to Auguste Arnaud on 8 June 1873 and 8 July 1873. Arnaud was married, the father of two, and a winemaker who regularly skipped Sunday Mass to work his vineyards. Our Lady appeared to him in the vineyard on 8 June and reminded him “You must not work on Sundays.” In honor of this blessing, Arnaud placed a cross and a statue of Mary at the site in the field.

On 8 July Our Lady appeared again, this time to both Auguste and his neighbors who had gathered there, and told them, “You must never work on Sunday! Blessed are those who believe.”

Happy Pentecost Sunday!

**Today we celebrate the Birth of the Church.** Each Pentecost is considered the feast that the Church begins its mission to evangelize the whole world. Pentecost takes place 50 days after Easter each year with the Apostles and Disciples receiving the Holy Spirit, “*God declares, that I will pour out my Spirit upon all flesh, and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy*”. The words in quotations are spoken by Peter to the multitude assembled, and the words he speaks are from the Old Testament Prophet Joel. Consider opening scripture to read all that Peter spoke to the crowd in the Book of Acts, Chapter 2:14-36. Peter may have made mistakes during the years walking with Jesus, but he sure nails the message of the Good News of the Gospel in these 22 verses.

The Holy Spirit is active in every baptized person and in the Catholic Tradition, at the time of receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation, the child of God, regardless of age, receives the fullness of the Holy Spirit to complete the Sacraments of Initiation that include, Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation. The gifts received at Confirmation are strengthened from baptism, as the person decides to be in full communion with the Catholic Church. The Gifts of the Holy Spirit are Wisdom, Understanding, Counsel, Fortitude, Knowledge, Piety, and Fear of The Lord.

**Wisdom**-we can think deeply about a situation, conflict, or experience and see things the way God sees them.

**Understanding**-we experience a compassionate awareness of what others think and feel.

**Counsel (right judgement)**-we can make good decisions based on what is right and wrong.

**Fortitude**-we experience the courage to overcome our fears.

**Knowledge**-we can make good decisions based on the information we have at hand.

**Piety (reverence)**-we can worship God more meaningfully.

**Fear of The Lord**-the Holy Spirit enables us to be in humble wonder and awe of God’s creation and of our relationship with Him.

The descriptions of the Gifts are brief, but always remember every one of the gifts listed above are to be interpreted in a right moral and ethical context surrounded by truth that is aligned with the Catholic Church.
