

A Message From Father Nate

An open hand or a grasped fist? Our readings this weekend give us a beautiful definition and invite conversation about faith. The reading on the letter to the Hebrews begins with, “Faith is the realization of what is hoped for and evidence of things not seen.” Hope in the Christian sense, Christian definition is not the same as **wish**. Hope is a theological virtue that points one’s direction and desires toward heaven.

When we talk about faith it is about trusting in God, and it is also about keeping an eternal vision. People have often heard me say, “raise your gaze!” This is a meant to keep our eyes fixed on the things that are pointing and leading us to heaven, “For where your treasure is, there also will your heart be.”

An obstacle to faith is our desire to control or to “have to know how it turns out”. Abraham did not exactly know what the Lord was inviting him to, but with eyes fixed on the eternal kingdom, he knew that it was going to be okay when he placed his trust in the Lord’s plan (even though he didn’t know what that meant). When we pray, we will often say that I am open to what the Lord wants me to do (as long as He wants me to do this...!) It is hard to trust where the Lord could invite me (us) because then I would need to step out of my comfort zone, into a place that I just am unfamiliar with.


In faith, do I lead with a closed fist? One that is “open” to the Lord, but not really. A faith that tells the Lord how it should be, tells the Lord what He should do? Or am I leading with an open hand? An openness to where the Lord is inviting, even if I don’t know how it is going to turn out? An open hand, a hand of surrender, begins with an eternal vision; keeping your eyes fixed on the Kingdom of Heaven! With that as the end goal, the Lord works to get us there! In prayer, envision your hands being open, an opportunity for trust, and soon your heart will match your actions!

Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary: This is a Holy Day of Obligation. We have Mass at 6:00 pm on Thursday, August 14th and 8:30 am on Friday August 15th. Please take this opportunity to honor Mary in the Mass as the Lord brings her to her heavenly reward!
