A Message From Deacon Gary

20th Sunday Ordinary Time

Today we hear in the second reading of Hebrews chapter 12, “*Brothers and sisters: Since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us rid ourselves of every burden and sin that clings to us and persevere in running the race that lies before us while keeping our eyes fixed on Jesus, the leader and perfecter of faith.*”

How about you? Do you recall family or friends in your life that lived such a healthy and marvelous Christian life that they modeled for you the beauty of knowing Jesus? They may be the great cloud of witnesses referred to in the scripture. These people may have passed onto eternal life or maybe they are living saints that continue to walk with us on our earthly journey. Let’s consider this paraphrase of scripture... “*Brothers and sisters: Since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, turn from sin and persevere keeping your eyes fixed on Jesus.*”

I hope several people come to mind as members of the great cloud of witnesses. Let’s go a step further... Are you considered one of those that model the Catholic Christian life as a witness for another? Just as you were watching the people that modeled the Catholic Christian life for you... are you now a Catholic Christian role model for others?


Consider the event we are experiencing this weekend at Holy Rosary. One of our own, that grew up as a member of our worshipping community, Jon Patrick Stone, in his early 20’s, is responding to the call to the priesthood through the Rite of Candidacy, a step of priestly formation.

Jon Patrick most likely had a great cloud of witnesses that modeled the Catholic Christian life for him. Some may have entered eternal life, and others may be in our midst. God placed these great witnesses in his life to model Jesus, and he continues to respond by being a witness to others.

Congratulations Jon Patrick Stone! Thank you for the Catholic Christian model you are for the Holy Rosary Community!
