## A Message From Fr. Nate

Striving to enter through the narrow gate takes a lot of sacrifice! I have always enjoyed being outside. When I get to spend time on the lake in a remote area, or walk through trails, or walk across the frozen lakes, there is something special about being outside. I have been fascinated for the last 15 years with watching creeks; how they enter a large body or water, or how the body of water narrows down to the creek. There is something incredibly peaceful about the narrowing of a large body of water into that small stream.

Strive to enter through the narrow way is a challenge, it is not easy! In our spiritual lives, this takes the form of praying when we are too busy, bringing the family to Mass when on vacation, parents praying with their children, etc. Strive to enter through the narrow way! It is comfortable to hang out in the comfort zone, but as Pope Benedict XVI said, "we are not made for comfort, but for greatness"! Be a witness, be an example of striving to enter through the narrow gate, because many hang out in the comfort zone; pursue greatness!






