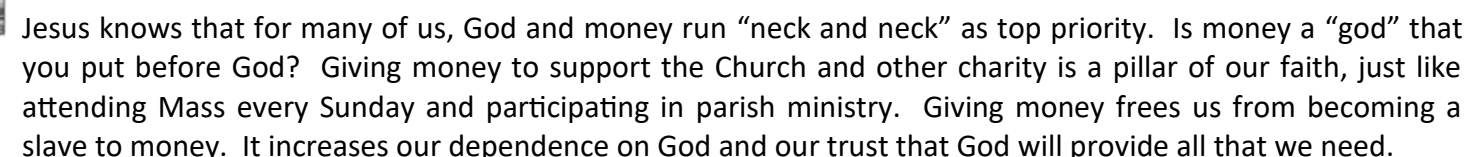


The Holy Father's Prayer Intentions of the Month
