Unique Mass celebration again this week! The Church celebrates the Dedication of St. John Lateran Basilica in Rome as a feast day. The readings and Mass setting take the place of our regular 32nd week in Ordinary Time.

St. John Lateran Basilica in Rome is one of the 4 major churches (St. Paul outside the Wall, St. Peter, and St. Mary Major) as run by Vatican City. The importance of St. John Lateran is that is the church that is occupied by the Bishop of Rome (the pope). This is considered the church that has the cathedra (office of the bishop) and the mother Church of the whole world. On a local level, this would be the cathedral for a diocese. St. John Lateran was dedicated by Pope Clement XII to Sts. John the Baptist and John the Evangelist.
