A Message From Fr. Nate

Christ the King Sunday This weekend marks the last Sunday in Ordinary Time. It is hard to believe that we are almost getting ready for the coming of Christ! Before we get to Advent though, we journey to the true King.

Our gospel reading is a familiar story of the thief on the cross next to Jesus as they were crucified. There is an interaction between the man and Jesus. The man, recognizing that Jesus is the King of Kings, says: "Jesus, remember me when you come into your Kingdom." An incredible moment of conversion for the man on the cross as he recognized Christ and what He could do. In his most difficult moment, the man was able to see Christ.

In our busyness, we can often lose sight of the King of Kings as well. One of the thieves was so wrapped up in himself that he missed Jesus, while the other was able to see where God was in the moment. As we go about our lives, in the good times and in the struggles, in the joys and the sorrows, when we are sick or healthy, or while we work or are retired, do you recognize the presence of the King of Kings? A simple prayer and example offered by the man crucified next to Christ gives us the words to say: "Jesus, remember me when you come into your Kingdom."

Next weekend is Advent...! During the Advent season we prepare our heart, mind, body, and soul for the coming of Christ. Be intentional this Advent season about preparing yourself and your family for the **PRESENCE** of Christ! Let this Advent be different than the other seasons: Hope, Peace, Joy, and Love!

Bishop Cozzens has asked the parishes in the Diocese of Crookston to use the chant Mass responses during the Advent Season. We did this for Lent this past year. Our cantors and choirs will lead us but know that we will be using the chant parts for the Mass responses.

St. Mary's Mission Appeal is next weekend. This collection is taken up across the diocese to assist the mission. Please give as generously as you are able and thank you for generosity!

Feeding the poor It has been a custom at Holy Rosary to put the small basket out for children to come and place their money in a basket during the time of the collection. Starting in Advent, we are no longer going to place the small basket out for money, but rather we will have baskets out for children to place a nonperishable food item in. We will collect the food over the course of the weekend and then it will be picked up by the local food shelf to be distributed to those in need within our community. Thank you for encouraging our children in this corporal work of mercy!


