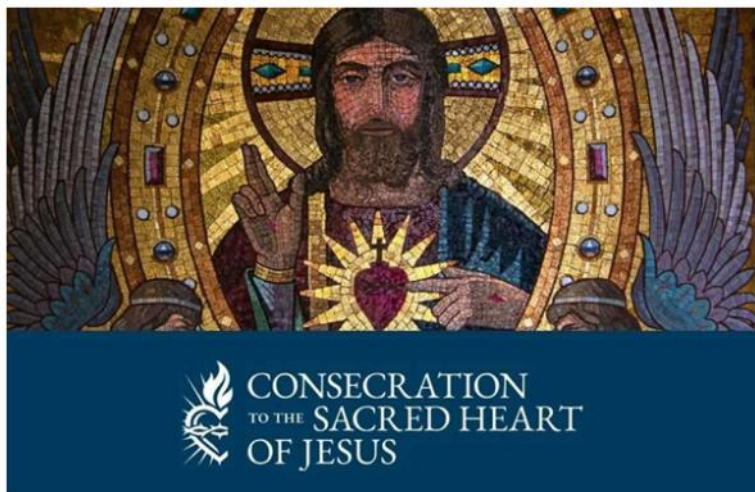

A Message From Fr Nate

Trinity Sunday: We often hear the phrase, “Good things come in three.” Our faith could not be truer! The Father creates us in love, the Son saves us through His sacrifice, and the Holy Spirit strengthens and guides us each day. Together, the Holy Trinity reminds us that we are never alone — we are continually surrounded by God’s presence and grace.

This Sunday, the Church celebrates the mystery and glory of the Holy Trinity: one God, three Persons — Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. The Trinity is the living relationship of divine love into which we are invited through Baptism and faith.

From the very beginning, Christians have prayed in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Every blessing, every sacrament, every Mass flows from the life of the Triune God. The Father creates and sustains us, the Son redeems us through His death and resurrection, and the Holy Spirit guides and strengthens the Church each day.

Holy Trinity Sunday reminds us that God is not isolated or distant from creation but is a communion. The love shared forever within the Trinity overflows into creation and calls us into deeper relationship with God **and with one another**. In a world often marked by division and isolation, the Trinity becomes both our model and our hope: a perfect unity rooted in love, humility, and self-gift.

In all that **we do**, may we reflect on the mystery of God’s presence in our lives. Though we may never fully comprehend the Trinity, we can experience God’s grace daily through prayer, Scripture, the sacraments, and the love we share as the Body of Christ lived in our community.
